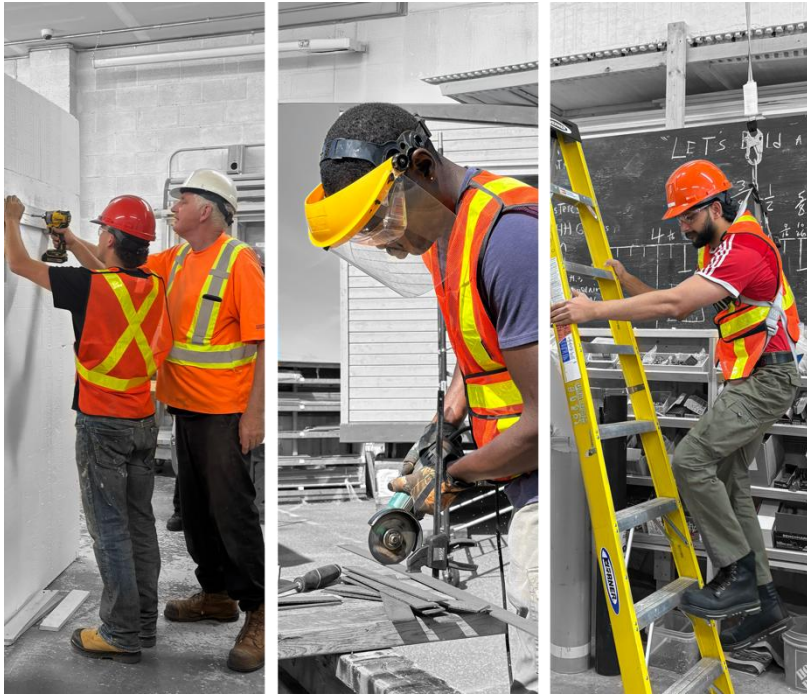

Eligibility Requirements – Does this sound like you?

- Skilled newcomers with a professional background in construction who are seeking to earn Canadian credentials in their field of training.
- Newcomers with experience in construction trades who are seeking to successfully transition into a career in the island construction industry.
- Living in Canada for less than 5 years & either a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a protected person or person with a valid work permit.
- Working 25 hours or less
- A Canadian language benchmark placement test of 6 or higher.
